New Managed Care Organizations (MCO's) (SE Region of PA):

Currently there are over 550,000 people who use Medical Assistance (MA) for health insurance coverage in the southeast region. **The following information does not apply to dual eligible individuals.**

- Aetna and Coventry (Health America), have been added to the MCO's serving the SE Region.
- The 5 managed care organizations in the SE region now include:
 - 1- Americhoice
 - 2- Health Partners
 - 3- Keystone Mercy
 - 4- Aetna
 - 5- Coventry (Health America)

Enrollment (Current Consumers):

- Enrollment information will be sent to all people who will be affected. Information about plans available will be specific to the zone in which the person resides.
- People will have the option to switch MCO's. However, if you do not respond, you will remain in your current program/MCO.

Enrollment (New Consumers):

- During a 6 month period Keystone Mercy will not be accepting any new people in an effort to assist the new MCO's in developing their membership. This adjustment took place as of February 12, 2010.
- Newly eligible individuals will have the opportunity to enroll in a MCO; however, those who do not choose a plan will be randomly auto-assigned to either Aetna or Coventry (Health America).

When enrolling please remember:

- 1) You can initiate a change in MCO/program at any time
- 2) Enrollment can be done online
