Are You on Medicare? New Medicare Cards are Coming!

From April 2018 through April 2019, Medicare is mailing new cards to every person with Medicare. The new cards will no longer have your Social Security number on it, but will have a NEW Medicare number that is unique to you. You do not have to do anything to get the new card--it will be mailed to your home, so please be sure your address is current with the Social Security Administration (SSA).

Has your address changed?

You can change your address online by using a [my Social Security](https://www.ssa.gov/myaccount/) account at <https://www.ssa.gov/myaccount/> or call 1-800-772-1213 to update your address information.

No one from Medicare will call or contact you for information. Once you get your new card, you should destroy your old card—shred it, or black-out your name and number with a black permanent marker before disposing of it. Because the mailing will take time, your card may arrive at a different time than your friend's or neighbor's.
