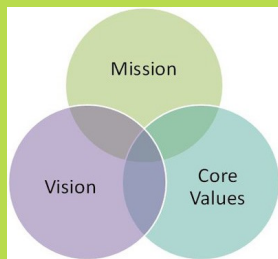


Our Mission
