Community Health Choices (CHC)

Community Health Choices (CHC) is a new program statewide for managed long term services and supports for individuals eligible for Medicare and Medical Assistance. Many of the eligible participants are often “Dual Eligible” meaning that they qualify for both Medicare and Medical Assistance. Along with dual eligibles, CHC will also include participants with the Aging, Attendant Care and Independence Waivers. This will begin on January 1, 2019 in the southeastern region of Pennsylvania and will provide services to more people in the community through the three available Managed Care Organizations (MCO’s).

Managed Care Organizations:

- Keystone First
- University of Pittsburgh Medical Center (UPMC)
- PA Health and Wellness (Centene)

The Target Population that **CHC will serve** are:

- Aging Waiver
- Attendant Care Waiver
- Independence Waiver
- OBRA Waiver
- Nursing Home Residents
- Dual Eligibles (most)

Exempt from CHC are:

- Consolidated, PFDS or Community Waivers
- Autism Waivers (Adult Autism or Adult Community Autism Program)
- OBRA Waiver (not nursing facility clinically eligible)
- State operated nursing facility residents
- LIFE program participants
